No Student is granted exemption from any of the Tests/Examinations.

*Promotion Criteria for classes IX and XI:

- 1. In order to be declared 'Passed' a student has to secure not less than 33% marks in theory as well as in Practicals separately in each subject.
- 2. If a student of class XI fails in 2 or more subjects, he/she will not be promoted to the next class. Retest will be given if he/she fails in one subject only. There will be no re-test for students failing in more than one subject.
- 3. If a students of class-IX fails in 3 or more subjects, he/she will not be promoted to the next class. Retest will be given if he/she fails in two subjects only. There will be no retest for students failing in more than two subjects.
